

**Holy Island
Educational Visit
8th May to 10th May 2024**



Dear Parents of Year 5 Pupils,

The itinerary for our field trip to Holy Island is as follows. Please note that some outdoor activities will be weather dependent.

Day 1 - Wednesday 8th May 2024

Pupils should arrive at school between 8.45 am and 9.00 am for registration purposes.

Depart from St Peter's Catholic Primary School: 9.30 am.

Lunch at Holy Island **[NB: Please provide a packed lunch for your child.]**

Settling into dormitories making beds etc, Island and site Induction.

Prayer Cairns/Lime Kilns, Bird Sanctuary/Wetlands.

Evening - Evening meal, Mini Olympics, Sunset walk, hot chocolate and bedtime.

Leave Holy Island and travel to Seahouses for a boat trip around the Farne Islands.

Return boat trip to Seahouses.

Lunch at Seahouses (Hook Fish and Chip Restaurant)

Leave Seahouses at approximately 1.00 pm

Your child(ren) will be supervised at all times.

Arrive back at school approximately 2.15 pm (traffic permitting). [NB: If applicable, you will be informed of any changes to the collection time via the Arbor App.]
