### **Wraparound care at St Peter's**

As previously corresponded to parents, we plan to offer wraparound provision at St Peter's from September. Many parents have expressed interest in this and so we have investigated various options. One of the options is to use a third-party provider and we are currently in talks with 2 different providers. The plan is that one of these will come into school and deliver the provision.

**One** of these third-party providers is Lamesley Childcare. I attached a short survey for you to complete before the holidays, but we have had very few responses. There are considerable costs involved in setting up a childcare business and it is essential you give us honest and accurate information concerning which days you would actually use **if** this service is to be delivered in school.
