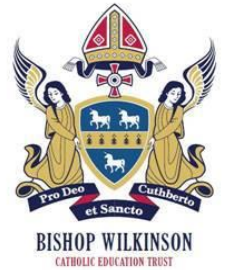

**EMMAUS YOUTH VILLAGE RESIDENTIAL TRIP 2024**

Further to the letter sent to parents on 26<sup>th</sup> January, please find attached further documentation regarding our Year 4 residential trip to Emmaus Youth Village in Consett from **Monday 10<sup>th</sup> June to Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2024**.

The main aim of the trip is to develop the children's spirituality as well as team-building aiding their Sacramental preparation. The theme of this retreat unpacks the idea that through salvation history God always shows his love to us. In the beginning, out of all that God created, we are his favourite; then through Jesus, God's only son, we are reminded how important we are, and today God shows his love through the people we meet, and his Spirit lives in every single one of us.

Please note the following points:

- The children will be accompanied by Miss Woods and other members of staff and will travel by coach leaving school at approximately 2.30 pm on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> June and returning for the end of the school day on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> June.
- **As the children will not be leaving school until 2.30 pm on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> June, your child's usual lunch arrangements will still apply on this day.**
- The cost per pupil is **£120.00** per child which includes accommodation, food and transport costs.
- The payment 'product' for this residential trip has been available in Arbor since 26<sup>th</sup> January giving parents the option to pay in four instalments or in one full payment by 31<sup>st</sup> May. If you have not already opted to pay by instalments or paid in full, please pay one full payment of £120.00 before 31<sup>st</sup> May 2024. **If you have any problems with this arrangement, please contact Mrs M<sup>c</sup>Arthur.**
- **Payment Details:** As we have introduced a new MIS system (Arbor Education), your online payment should be paid via the Arbor app (Trips section). If you have any difficulty accessing the Arbor app, please contact the School Office. We hope that you will find that paying in this way is much more convenient and, from our perspective, it will save us time as well as reduce the chances of money being lost.
- **On-line Consent:** When paying online, please confirm that you give your consent for your child to attend this residential field trip. [NB: There is an inherent risk involved with attending this residential trip and consent to attending this residential trip assumes that you have accepted this risk.]
