Visit to Safety Works!, Newcastle upon Tyne

We are delighted to inform you that our pupils in Year 1 and Year 2 will be visiting Safety Works!, Newcastle upon Tyne *on Tuesday 11th June (from 1.00 to 3.00 pm)*. Safety Works! provides realistic, interactive learning experiences for the prevention of danger and guidance for living more safely. These experiences are both innovative and enjoyable.

Please note the following points:

- The children will be accompanied by Mrs Moreland, Mrs Pedro and other adults and will travel by coach (leaving school at 12.30 pm and returning for the end of the school day).
- The children should wear their *school uniform*.
- As the pupils will be leaving school at 12.30 pm, your child's usual lunch arrangements will still apply.
- The cost of the trip is £9.50 (to cover travel expenses and admission fee).
- <u>Payment Details</u>: As we have introduced a MIS system (Arbor Education), your online payment should be paid via the Arbor Parent/Carer app (Trips section). <u>Please note that we do not accept cash or cheque payments for school trips</u>. If you have any difficulty accessing the Arbor Parent/Carer app, please contact the School Office. We hope that you will find that paying in this way is much more convenient and, from our perspective, it will save us time as well as reduce the chances of money being lost.
- On-line Consent: When paying online, please confirm that you give your consent for your child to attend this educational visit. [NB: There is an inherent risk involved with attending this educational visit and consent to attending this educational visit assumes that you have accepted this risk.]
- Your online payment and online consent are required by Friday 24th May.
- Children who suffer from asthma must bring their inhalers with them.
