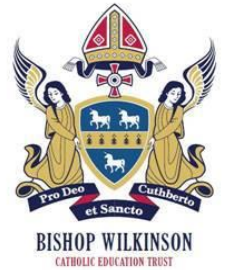

## TO THE PARENTS OF PUPILS IN YEAR 6

Dear Parents,

### Business Week

Over the next few weeks, the Year 6 pupils will be involved in our school business week initiative.

On Monday 10<sup>th</sup> July, the children participated in 'Money Matters', a financial education workshop delivered by St James's Place Wealth Management. This was an exciting opportunity for the children to understand the world of business and finance and hopefully help them to make wise choices when planning their own business opportunity later this half term and indeed help with important decisions they will make in the future.

After the workshop, the children will spend time in class focusing on enterprise, project management and working together as a team and then they will choose their own business idea and will work in small groups. **The children will be given the opportunity to sell their produce to the rest of the school during the week commencing Monday 24<sup>th</sup> June.**

Each member of the group will contribute £5 which will be used to buy resources for their chosen project. In the past, the children were given £5 cash at the beginning of the project, however, as we are now part of the Bishop Wilkinson Academy Trust, we are a 'cashless' school so we are unable to provide the cash for the initial outlay to the children. As a consequence, we have no option but to ask that you contribute £5 towards your child's project and this payment will be reimbursed from the profits at the end. **[NB: There is no need to send your £5 contribution into school as the children will be responsible for buying the items for their own specific project.]**
