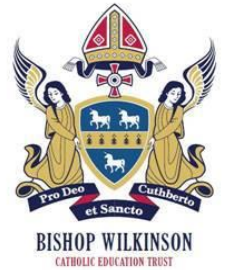

**Diocesan Primary Schools' Summer Festival – Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June**

Our Year 6 pupils will be attending the Diocesan Primary Schools' Summer Festival which will take place at Emmaus Village, in Consett, **on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June**. We are looking forward to a wonderful festival event with over 400 Year 6 pupils from many different parts of the Diocese.

Please note the following points:

- The children will be accompanied by Mrs Brown and other adults and will travel by coach (leaving school at **8.40 am** and **returning for approximately 5.00 pm**). **[NB: Please ensure that your child arrives at school in time for registration at 8.30 am.]**
- The children must wear their **school uniform**.
- The children will need to bring a **packed lunch** (no glass bottles please).
- The subsidised cost of this visit is £14.00 per pupil (to cover travel expenses).
- Payment Details: As we have introduced a MIS system (Arbor Education), your online payment should be paid via the Arbor Parent/Carer app (Trips section). Please note that we do not accept cash or cheque payments for school trips. If you have any difficulty accessing the Arbor Parent/Carer app, please contact the School Office.
- On-line Consent: When paying online, please confirm that you give your consent for your child to attend this educational visit. [NB: There is an inherent risk involved with attending this educational visit and consent to attending this educational visit assumes that you have accepted this risk.]
- Your online payment and online consent are required by Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> June.
- The children should apply **sun protection and insect repellent spray/cream**, if necessary, **before** school.
- Children who suffer from asthma should bring their inhalers with them.
- Children who suffer from hayfever should have their medication **before** school.
- Please refer to the attached information regarding the YMT Outreach Project 2024. Anyone wishing to donate food items for the project, should send the items into school with your child **on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> June**.
- **Photograph/Video Consent:** Members of the Youth Ministry Team will be taking photographs and videos during the event which will be used in the Northern Cross (the Diocesan Newspaper) and in Youth Ministry Team publicity. **Your consent is required so please complete the 'Photograph/Video Consent' section of the attached reply-slip.**
