Internet	A global computer network providing a variety of information and communication facilities, consisting of interconnected networks
Network	A group or system of interconnected people or things
Website	A set of related web pages located under a single domain name
Web browser	An application software that allows access to explore the World Wide Web
World Wide Web	An information system that enables content sharing over the Internet
Download	To copy data from one computer system to the next
Ownership	Who has the right to control data
Permission	To allow access
Sharing	Providing access to digital media
