Holy Trinity	The Trinity, or Holy Trinity, is a way of describing God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.
Sign of the Cross	The Sign of the Cross is a prayer. Each time that we make the Sign of the Cross and pray the words we give praise to the three Persons of the Blessed Trinity.

consequences	that which follows; result.
responsibilities	something for which a person is responsible; duty.
