<b>Lectern</b>	a tall stand with a sloping top which holds the bible, so that it can be read.
<b>Word of God</b>	The words spoken by God
<b>Liturgical year</b>	The different seasonal times in the church's calendar.
<b>Christian family</b>	Family brought together by faith
<b>seasons</b>	Periods of time within the church year
